A director, actor, producer and educator; Jeremy is a native Floridian who recently came home to South Florida after living and working in and around NYC for 22 years. Before leaving New York, he was the Producing Artistic Director of White Plains Performing Arts Center, a 410-seat Equity regional theatre in Westchester County.

He has acted in or directed over 300 theatrical productions over the span of 40+ years including, but not limited to; Off & Off-Off Broadway, three National Tours and numerous regional productions across the country. In June of 2017, Jeremy had the significant honor of directing the 73rd Annual *Theatre World Awards* at the Imperial Theatre on Broadway. Mr. Quinn recently directed the National Tour of *Old Jews Telling Jokes* and *Emergency* for the NY Theatre Festival as well as a production of *Young Frankenstein* in Boca Raton and *Noises Off* at Delray Beach Playhouse. Recent acting credits include “Myles Connor Jr.” in *Art Heist* at the Broward and Kravis Centers for the Performing Arts and “Albert/Bessie” in *Casa Valentina* at Empire Stage in Ft. Lauderdale. He has appeared in films, on television, in commercials, on radio and in voice-overs including cartoons.

Mr. Quinn is a member of the prestigious Lincoln Center Theater Directors Lab, was an Associate Producer for Broadway for a New America and is currently a member of the Board of Directors for the South Florida Shakespeare Troupe, a Judge for the South Florida Carbonell Awards and Founder/CEO/President of South Florida Theatremakers.
