Acting I focused on improvisation and moment-to-moment intentions as well as creative visualization and encouragement to discover logical character behavior. Emphasis was also made on vocal and physical flexibility; further strengthening the actor's vocal process while developing power, clarity and resonance through physical relaxation, vocal exercises and use of text.
- **Teacher of Acting II** – Acting II spent more time on script analysis and character development and showed how to bring a scene to "life" through fundamentals of superobjectives, scenic objectives and actions while working from a foundation of honesty and commitment with emphasis on bold, unique, interesting choices.
- In both classes there was an extensive use of Spolin improvisation techniques as well as practical uses of Stanislavski, Uta Hagen and Sanford Meisner with physical movement based on Alexander and voice & speech based on the techniques of Linklater.

Produced and directed a production of Naomi Iizuka's *Polaroid Stories* using a combination of live actors and puppets.
